



M40 J11 new Traffic Signal installation update

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review.

We have postponed all face-to-face engagement events and meetings and have put in place a number of channels to communicate with communities, such as letters and phone calls, as well as updates and alerts from each of the local community websites.

We are writing to update you on a series of proposed (tbc) traffic island and slip & approach lane closures on the M40 J11 in September, October and November, between the hours of 20:00hrs to 06:00hrs required for the installation of new traffic signalling. This is additional to the ongoing Lane closure that we currently have in place.

What are we doing?

We will continue to carrying out our ongoing lane closures on the M40 J11, but certain works require that closures around the roundabout and slip / approach roads are required. The works will enable the construction of new duct crossings across the traffic island carriageways and installation of new traffic signal loops to the Motorway slip lanes and A road approaches. The proposed night time closures will require diversions.
